## 1st VP Event – Tour of Capitol

Our 1st VP event for November was a tour of the Utah State Capitol building in downtown Salt Lake City. Thirty Newcomers attended. We split into two groups, each with a knowledgeable guide to take us all around the building's interior. We learned about the history of the building, the art inside, and the massive renovation a few years ago, which included a new base isolation system that will allow the building to survive as much as a 7.3 magnitude earthquake. We also got to see where our legislature meets when it is in session.

After our tour, we were joined by Senator John Johnson and Senator Ron Winterton, the two Utah State Senators who represent the Park City area. They were very cordial and congenial, spending over an hour with us and handling some tough questions from the group. It was a real highlight to have such personal access to our senators.

For those who were up for some food, we went to the Nauvoo Cafe inside the Joseph Smith Memorial Building on South Temple. Good, casual food, reasonably priced.


