THE COFFEE'S ON!!! Join us outside at City Park for our first coffee get-together since March: it's a purely social event -- time to catch up and enjoy each other's company.

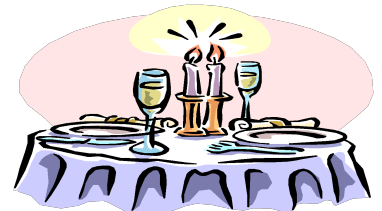
