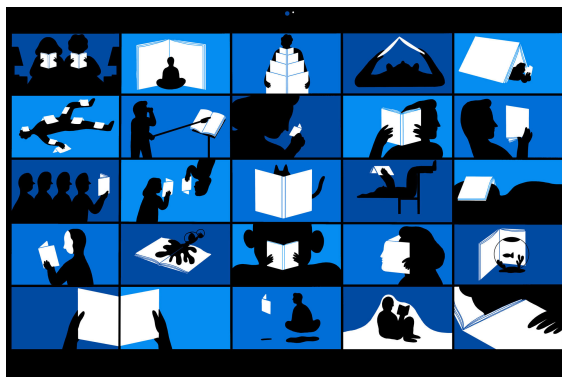

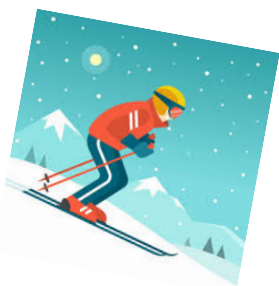

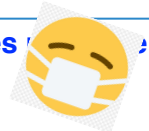
## Shooting Group
