Brant Lucas, Wildfire Liaison from the Park City Fire District, will discuss residential landscaping for fire protection, fire resistant plants, and how National Firewise Standards can lower homeowners' insurance rates in certified neighborhoods. Wild fires are becoming larger and more frequent each year. It's been an issue for years that only becomes more critical with climate warming (less water and higher temperatures). As homeowners and gardeners we need to do our part to protect our homes! We will meet at Pat Pond's home, where, last year, she had 12 trees removed whose branches were overhanging her roof. Brant will take us around the house to show other measures she can take to protect her property.

Special Note! Our **annual perennial swap** is back this year! It is a great way to share the abundance in our gardens. Everyone should come with a nice size labeled perennial in a pot. **Please dig and pot your plant 3-4 weeks ahead of the Swap** so that it becomes acclimated to the pot and doesn't look half dead! If you don't have perennials that you can split, you can also purchase a perennial to bring to the swap -- better yet, ask a friend with an established garden to dig something in his or her garden. We want to share perennials that we know will grow in Park City!


Call, text or email the host of the month (Carol for the June date) to request your choice of dishes to bring. **Please call asap since space will be limited.**

What is Fine Dining?

It's a wonderful way to meet other Newcomers in a more intimate setting. It's for couples and singles who like to cook, eat, and share conversation around the table.

How does it work?

Groups of 8 (couples or two singles) dine together monthly for a 4-month period at a member's home, rotating locations each month. The Fine Dining Coordinators provide a menu and recipes for each dinner.

- Each group schedules their own dinner dates with each couple taking a turn to host all 8 members of the group.
- Dates are scheduled in a collaborative manner so the most members of the group can participate. The Coordinators have a list of alternates to fill in, in case there is a gap. (Alternates do not have to host a dinner.)
- The host prepares the main course and sets the table. Other group members prepare and bring the other courses (appetizer, salad/soup, dessert).
- Everyone brings their own wine or other beverage of choice.
- After the 4-month cycle, each couple/pair of singles will have hosted. New groups are formed for the next cycle.

What if I can't host 8 people for dinner in my home?

No problem. If you are a single, team up with another single (we can try to help you find a dining partner) who has a home that can accommodate 8 for dinner. Or, you can act as an alternate, filling in and bringing one of the dishes to one of the dinners.

Don't feel you have to be a "gourmet cook!" Just be interested in cooking, willing to experiment with new recipes, enjoy eating and getting to know others. Groups are supportive and your Coordinators will help you!
