




In July of 2018, Mountain Town Olive Oil started offering a food and wine pairing class, called the Next Course. Located behind the store, the Next Course features a private chef demonstrating 3-5 recipes each week, with helpful tips on how to prepare each dish, what oils and vinegars, spices and herbs are being used.

Guests can interact with the chef, asking questions and getting ideas on how to use their favorite flavors. Wines are paired to each dish, with information on how and why each wine was selected.
